CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT PRACTICES PLAN

Pursuant to District Rule 402.2 (Agricultural Operations), <u>All</u> commercial agricultural operations 10 acres and larger, <u>Must Submit</u> a Conservation Management Practices (CMP) Plan to the District. A CMP Plan includes activities and practices farmers implement on their farms to help reduce, mitigate, or prevent fugitive dust.

A complete plan should include at least one (1) CMP from each of the following categories: Land Preparation and Cultivation; Harvest Activities; Unpaved Roads and Traffic Areas; Windblown Dust/Cropland-Other. Completion of this form can serve as a valid CMP Plan upon District approval. A separate CMP plan must be submitted and approved for each crop and each site farmed.

A \$130 filing/review fee, paid by check or money order, is required with all CMP plan submittals.
