SUBJECT: Adoption of Draft Rule 210.1A, (Major New and Modified Stationary Source Review (MNSR))

Honorable Board:

Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) is proposing to adopt draft Rule 210.1A, (Major New and Modified Stationary Source Review (MNSR)). On May 17, 2022, the District held a public workshop at the District Board Room located at: 414 W. Tehachapi Boulevard Suite D, Tehachapi, CA 93561, to present proposed draft Rule 210.1A. District staff submitted copies of the proposed amendments to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) and Region IX of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for review. A 30-day public review and comment period followed the workshop. No comments from the public or CARB were received and EPA recommended adopting the rule.

Draft Rule 210.1A is being adopted to provide for preconstruction review and insure the applicant provides an analysis demonstrating Best Available Control Technology (BACT) has been proposed for each emission unit included in a new major stationary source, or major modification of an existing major stationary source.

Rule 210.1A will become effective immediately upon Board adoption. A Notice of Public Hearing was duly published more than 30 days prior to this hearing in the following newspapers: Mojave Desert News, Daily Independent, Tehachapi News, and Bakersfield Californian. The notice requested written comments on draft Rule 210.1A and associated staff reports be submitted by July 27, 2022. A copy of the staff report, which includes the proposed draft rule, is attached.

IT IS RECOMMENDED your Board Open Hearing; Receive Public Comment; Close Hearing; Adopt Draft Rule 210.1A, (Major New and Modified Stationary Source Review (MNSR)), and Resolution Number 2022-002-07.
