SUBJECT: Agreement 07-006-2026 with Muroc Joint Unified School District to Install Two Electric School Bus Charging Stations

Honorable Board:

The Muroc Joint Unified School District (MJUSD) has applied for funding through the Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) Community Air Protection (CAP) incentive program. CAP provides funding for reductions of criteria and toxic emissions in disadvantaged or low-income communities. MJUSD has proposed an eligible project to install two 60kw, single-port Level III electric school bus charging stations at their transportation yard in Boron.

Agreement 07-006-2026 will provide MJUSD 100% funding up to a maximum of \$241,727.00 in CAP funds for the equipment and construction costs associated with installing the two electric school bus charging stations.

Three copies of the proposed agreement, a sample copy of which is attached, were sent to the grantee to approve by signature and expected to be returned to the District prior to the Board Meeting. If any significant changes are identified by the applicant, the item will be withdrawn, and the Agreement will be held to the September 2026 Board Meeting.

IT IS RECOMMENDED your Board approve and authorize Chairman to sign Agreement 07-006-2026 with Muroc Joint Unified School District for installation of the two electric school bus charging Stations.
