2023 DMV GRANT VOUCHER PROGRAM

I. DMV Grant Program Background

The Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control District (District) receives annual AB 2766 funds through an “air quality impact” fee collected by the DMV. Revenues generated from AB 2766 are used to reduce air pollution generated from motor vehicles and their related activities.

The District allocates a substantial portion of AB 2766 funds to its DMV Grant Program and DMV Grant Voucher Program. Both grant programs provide a mechanism for the fair, unbiased distribution of AB 2766 funds to eligible motor vehicle related emission reduction projects located within Eastern Kern County. This document is intended to provide applicant guidance pertaining to the vehicle voucher component of the District’s DMV Grant Program. If you are interested in applying for an infrastructure, road paving, or public education grant, please see the 2023 DMV Grant Program Guidelines.

II. Voucher Program Overview

The District offers financial incentive, in the form of a voucher, for the **purchase, not lease** of a new eligible lower-emitting vehicle. The District’s DMV Grant Voucher Program begins October 1st of each year and is on-going until all funds have been awarded. Applications are processed first-come first-served and vouchers are issued accordingly. Voucher awards and the associated new vehicle emission classification requirements are as follows:

1. **\$4,000** for purchase of a Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) electric vehicle and with a California Smog Score of 10;
2. **\$2,000** for purchase of a Partial Zero Emission Vehicle (PZEV) or Alternative Technology Partial Zero Emission Vehicle (ATPZEV) and with a California Smog Score of 8 or 9, this includes some hybrid vehicles.

III. Eligibility Requirements

1. You must apply and be issued a voucher prior to purchasing the new vehicle. No retroactive payments will be made.
2. Vehicle must be a new purchase from a dealership, not a lease, and not used.
3. Applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
4. Applicant must primarily reside in Eastern Kern County and provide proof of residency. Proof of residency can include copy of driver’s license or a piece of mail (utility, cable bill, ect.) with name and address located within Eastern Kern County.
5. If the applicant is a business, school, non-profit organization, government agency, municipality, or entity, the physical address must be located within Eastern Kern County.
6. Applicant must submit a completed, signed original DMV Grant Voucher Program Application and proof of residency to the District’s Administrative office.

Be Advised:

District reserves the right to reject any or all applications.

District may request additional information after the application has been submitted.

All applications become property of the District.

All applications are subject to the public information act.

Applicant should notify the District immediately if there is a need to withdraw an application.

Voucher is valid for a period of six (6) months from its issuance date. If the voucher is not used by its expiration date it will become void.

IV. Voucher

An eligible applicant will be issued one DMV Grant Voucher (stating grant award amount, vehicle emission class, and expiration date). The voucher is used as a place-holder guarantying funds will be available to the Grantee for reimbursement after purchasing the new eligible vehicle within the expiration date. The Grantee must not purchase the new vehicle prior to receiving the voucher. **No retroactive payments will be made.**

V. Payment

The Grantee must submit the following documents to the District in order to receive reimbursement after purchasing a new eligible vehicle from a dealership that does not participate in the DMV Grant Voucher program:

- A completed District DMV Grant Voucher Program Claim for Payment Form;
- A completed IRS Form W9;
- A copy of the sales invoice for the new eligible vehicle that was purchased;
- The original unscratched DMV Grant Voucher.

Be Advise: The new vehicle must meet the emissions criteria listed on the voucher in order to be eligible for payment. The Grantee name listed on the voucher must also match the buyer's name listed on the new vehicle sale's contract.

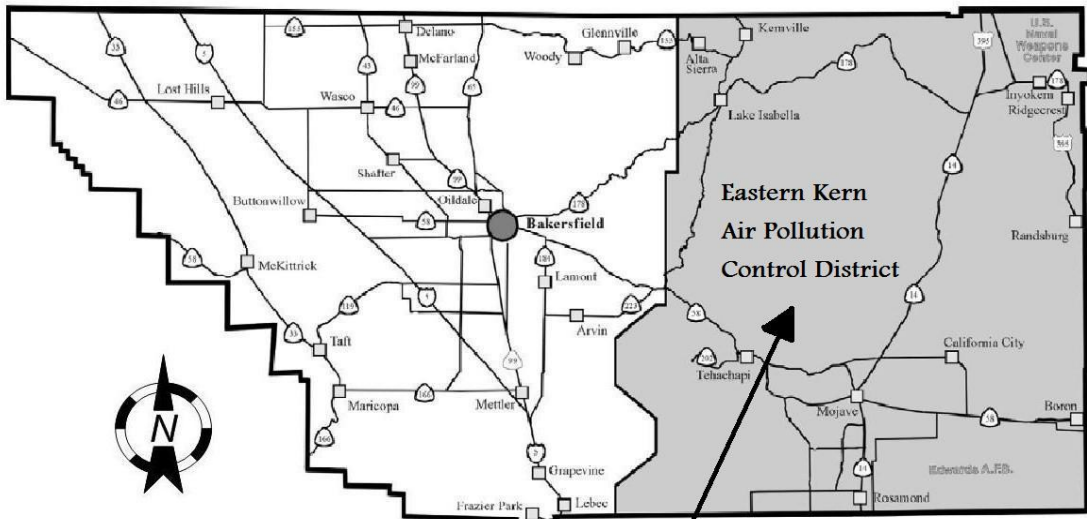
