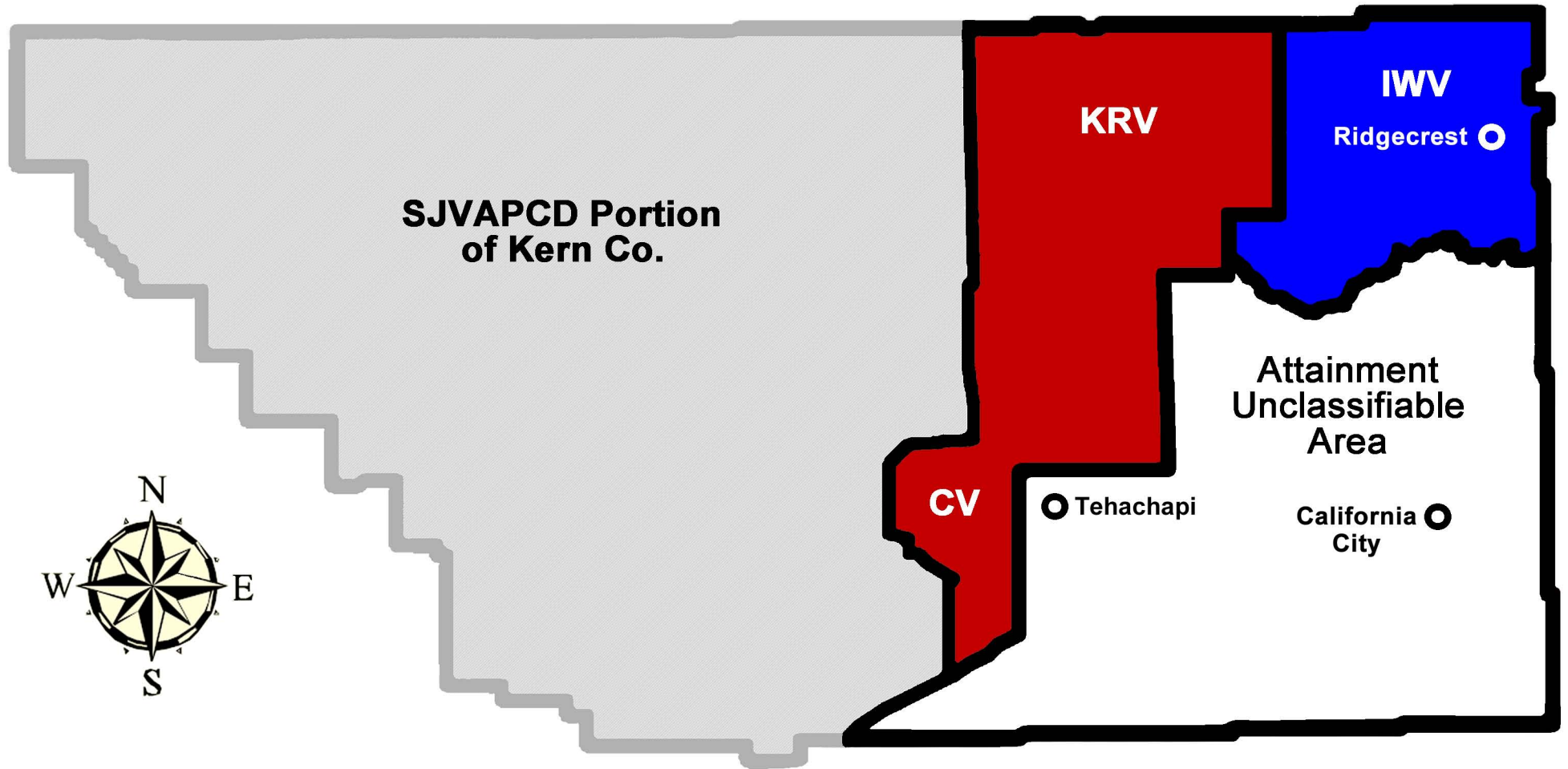






# Eastern Kern APCD PM<sub>10</sub> Federal Attainment Status



## National Ambient Air Quality Standards Designations for Particulate Matter PM<sub>10</sub>

-  Nonattainment/Serious - Kern River Valley (KRV) & Cummings Valley (CV) - Extends from the Kern County/Tulare County border in the Lake Isabella area south through Walker Basin to Rancho La Liebre (Includes Bear Valley Springs and Stallion Springs)
-  Attainment/Maintenance - Indian Wells Valley (IWV) - Inyokern/Ridgecrest area
-  Attainment/Unclassifiable area of EKAPCD (Remainder of EKAPCD)
-  SJVAPCD Portion of Kern County (Attainment/Maintenance)

<sup>1</sup>Kern River Valley, Bear Valley and Cummings Valley were previously included in the federally designated San Joaquin Valley PM10 Serious Nonattainment Area, but was made a separate nonattainment area in 2008

<sup>2</sup>Kern River Valley, Bear Valley and Cummings Valley are included with the EKAPCD for all NAAQS other than PM10

<sup>3</sup>For PM10 and first 8-hour ozone NAAQS(0.08 ppm) the Indian Wells Valley was split-out as a separate planning area from the rest of the EKAPCD

<sup>4</sup>Indian Wells Valley is only a separate area for the PM10 and first 8-hour Ozone NAAQS (0.08 ppm) and is part of the EKAPCD for all other NAAQS

<sup>5</sup>Indian Wells Valley is included with the rest of the EKAPCD in the proposed designated nonattainment area under the 2007 revision of the 8-Ozone NAAQS (0.075 ppm)

<sup>6</sup>1-hour ozone NAAQS was revoked effective June 15, 2004

<sup>7</sup>EKAPCD was attainment of 1-hour ozone NAAQS at time of revocation; the proposed Attainment Maintenance designation's effective date was June 21, 2004, therefore it did not become effective
