WOOD SMOKE REDUCTION PROGRAM 2023 GUIDELINES

REQUIREMENTS

The Eastern Kern Air Pollution Control (District) is offering rebate vouchers to Eastern Kern homeowners to replace Non-EPA certified wood/pellet stove with a new EPA certified wood/pellet stove, or to install an EPA certified gas, electric, or catalytic fireplace insert **into a home that uses the heating device as a source of heat**. Applications will be accepted until grant funds are depleted. Vouchers will be awarded first-come, first-served basis. A Completed application must be signed by the homeowner and submitted to the District. **No retroactive vouchers will be issued.**

1. The Wood Smoke Reduction Program (WSRP) is only available to Eastern Kern homeowners.
2. The new wood/pellet stove or fireplace insert must be used as a home's source of heat.
3. The wood/pellet stove being replaced must be uncertified. Any woodstove not having a particulate matter emission standards label affixed installed prior to 1988, is considered uncertified.
4. The new device must be one of the following: EPA certified woodstove, pellet stove, or catalytic wood/pellet, natural gas, propane, or electric insert.
5. Eligible wood/pellet stove, or wood/pellet insert must have a particulate matter emission rate not exceeding 2.0 g/h. Only EPA Certified Step 2 devices will be eligible.
6. The Standard Voucher is valued at **\$2,500**. Please be aware that the Standard Voucher amount may not cover the entire cost of the new cleaner device, installation, required permits or any code upgrade that may be required.
7. Low-Income Voucher is valued at **\$4,000**. The Low-Income Voucher is available for an applicant that can demonstrate eligibility by providing proof of participation in one of the following low-income assistance programs:
 - U.S. Department of Agriculture Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program;
 - U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP);
 - California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) Program with any utility company.
8. The new home heating device must be professionally installed in accordance with local fire and building codes by a licensed participating retailer. Please contact the District for the list of participating retailers. The applicant is responsible for scheduling the in-home estimate. Any applicable building permits must be obtained prior to installation of the new device. **NO DO-IT-YOURSELF INSTALLATIONS ARE ALLOWED.**
9. The applicant must redeem the voucher within sixty (60)-days from the date of issuance from a participating retailer. The voucher will be applied as an instant rebate off the total cost of the new home heating device. Installation must occur within one-hundred and twenty (120)-days of voucher issuance. The voucher expiration date may be extended at the discretion of the District.

10. The applicant must arrange post inspection within forty-five (45) days of the completed job to verify work and satisfy any applicable building permit requirement. This includes providing entry into your property and home. Failure to do so will result in forfeit of the voucher and any WSRP funds.
11. Old heating device replaced through this program must be removed from service and surrendered to the participating retailer, who will render it permanently inoperable and properly recycle it. The participating retailer shall take a photo of the old heating device prior to removing it, and a photo of the new installed heating device. Photos shall be submitted to the District with claim for payment.
12. Participating retailer or their licensed installer shall provide homeowner training on new device operation and maintenance, and proper wood storage and wood burning practices (if applicable).

HOW TO APPLY

If you own and reside in a home located within the District's jurisdiction (see map below and list of communities on page 3 to determine jurisdiction), that uses a fireplace or uncertified wood/pellet stove as a source of heat, you are eligible to apply. Complete all sections of the WSRP Application (page 4), review and sign the Applicant Certification (page 5). Include at least one photo of your current non-certified wood burning device and provide a copy of your current utility bill to verify name/address.

- **Applications must be mailed or hand delivered.**
- **FAXED or Emailed applications will not be accepted.**

APPLICANT CERTIFICATION

I certify the following:

1. I understand that only a currently installed and operating non-EPA certified wood/pellet stove of fireplace used as a source of heat is eligible for replacement/upgrading under this program.
2. I understand that I must be the homeowner and limited to receiving one rebate voucher per address.
3. I understand that applications are processed in the order they are received, vouchers will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis, funding is limited, and a voucher rebate is not guaranteed.
4. I understand the voucher must be redeemed within 60-days from the date of its issuance and work must be completed within 120-days. Voucher expiration date may be extended at the discretion of the District but is not guaranteed. No retroactive vouchers are available.
5. I understand applications will only be accepted for homes located in Eastern Kern County (see Map on page 2 and Community List on page 3).
6. I understand I must surrender my old heating device to the installer/retailer upon installation of the new heating device.
7. I understand the heating device purchased with funds from this program must be professionally installed by a licensed contractor, and that there may be additional costs for installation including a local permit. Installations must comply with all local fire and building codes.
8. I understand the participating retailer installing the new heating device is responsible for properly disposing and recycling the old heating device.
9. I understand I must arrange and allow all post inspections to verify completed work within 45-days of completed installation. This includes providing entry onto my property and into my home.
10. I understand that I am responsible for paying the retailer any cost exceeding my voucher amount associated with the purchase price and installation of the new certified heating device.
11. I understand that I will forfeit my voucher if I provide the District with false information or fail to obtain any required permit or if any required information is not submitted to the District prior to the expiration date listed on the voucher.
12. I understand the District does not warranty any heating device purchased under this voucher program, including, but not limited to, the quality or functionality of the device.
13. I understand that proper wood burning practices (e.g., burning only dry, seasoned wood) and proper stove installation and operation (e.g., maintaining a hot fire) are critical to the effectiveness of my new device.
14. I agree to receive training on the new heating device operation and maintenance, and proper wood storage and wood burning practices (if applicable) from the participating retailer/installer.
15. I understand that the District may inspect all work and associated records.
16. I understand applications will be treated in accordance with Public Records Act requirements. Certain information, subject to those requirements, may be publicly disclosed.
