**NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP
ON PROPOSED CONTROL MEASURE DEVELOPMENT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public workshop will be held on **Wednesday, November 15, 2006 at 1:30 p.m. at Golden Hills Community Service District, 21415 Reeves Street, Tehachapi, CA**, to discuss and receive comments on proposed control measures to satisfy requirements for:

- **Reasonably Available Control Technology (Clean Air Act RACT)**
- **Readily Available Particulate Matter Control (Health and Safety Code §39614)**

The Kern County Air Pollution Control District (KCAPCD) is required by the federal Clean Air Act to adopt reasonably available control technology (RACT) for all stationary sources of ozone as part of the KCAPCD's 8-hour Ozone State Implementation Plan. RACT is the lowest emission limitation that a source is capable of meeting by the application of control technology that is reasonably available considering technological and economic feasibility. Staff has reviewed the District's rules to identify any RACT deficiencies. Staff will present proposed RACT control measures necessary to correct identified deficiencies and a proposed RACT implementation schedule at the workshop.

The KCAPCD is required by Senate Bill 656 (Sherwood), codified as Health and Safety Code §39614, to reduce public exposure to PM10 and PM2.5 (collectively referred to as PM). KCAPCD staff is required to review the state's list of most readily available, feasible and cost effective particulate matter (PM) control measures and identify those that could reduce PM exposure in the KCAPCD. Staff has identified several PM control strategies from the state's list that are appropriate for KCAPCD to consider. Staff will present these proposed PM control measures and a proposed implementation schedule for PM rule development at the workshop.

Please be aware that the purposes for this workshop is to discuss control measure concepts and that proposed rules have not yet been developed. Additional workshops will be held to present draft rules and allow additional comment.

On October 25, 2006, the RACT and PM Control Measures staff report identifying proposed control measures will be available at District's website: www.kernair.org.
